ACCESSIBILITY BARRIERS

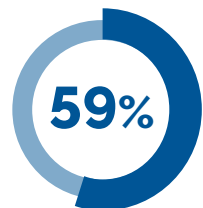
100%

of young people with disability who had accessed youth services, had **faced accessibility barriers**



Only **1 in 5**

young people with disability said if they couldn't access a service, they would **contact the organisation for support or adjustments**

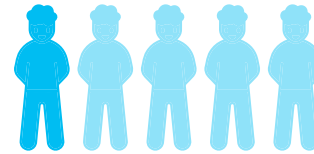


59% of young people with disability **have had difficulty accessing work or volunteer opportunities** in the past

SELF ADVOCACY

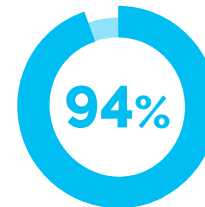
1 in 5

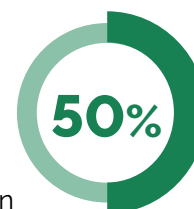
of young people with disability indicated they wanted **more information about disability rights**



BARRIERS TO ACCESSING YOUTH SERVICES

CONFIDENCE

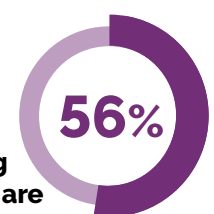
47%
