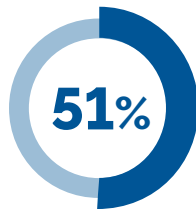
Creating Access



WORKERS EXPERIENCE

51%

of youth workers who responded **work with young people with disability all of the time or regularly.**



STAFF TRAINING

54%

of youth workers had not, or were unsure if they had, **received disability rights or awareness training**



COMMUNICATION

Only **57%**

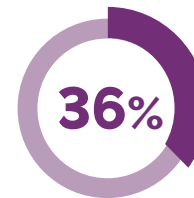
of youth workers said they feel **confident communicating with a young person with disability**



SELF ADVOCACY

36%

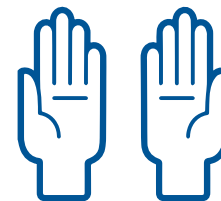
of youth workers were unsure, or felt **not very confident, explaining self-advocacy to a young person with disability**



Factors youth workers think make a service accessible for young people with disability:

youth workers said that they believed having an **attitudinally accessible team (friendly, welcoming, approachable, patient workers)** would make their service more accessible to young people with disability



Resources youth workers want to increase confidence when working with young people with disability:
