We are looking for 7 people to be on our Board.


We call these people **PWDA Directors**.

# How to put in a nomination



This part is about how to put in a PWDA Director nomination.



You can put in a nomination for

- Yourself
- · Someone else.



When you put in a nomination you must have someone who says they agree with you.

This person is a **seconder**.



We can help you find a seconder if you do not have one.



You must give us the email address of the seconder.

This is so we can ask if they agree with your nomination.



You can use our online form to put in a nomination.



You can also print the nomination form and fill in a paper copy.



The last day you can put in a nomination is Monday 5 September 2022.
